WHITES

Sugarloaf Mountain Vineyards - Pinot Grigio (Dickerson, MD 2021)

A traditional Italian-style Pinot Grigio that is light, crisp, and dry. With refreshing notes of lime zest and lemon, this wine is perfect on a hot summer day!

Flannery Hill - Sauvignon Blanc - (Marlborough, New Zealand 2020)

Passionfruit and orange blossom aromas. Flavors of grapefruit & pineapple on the finish.

Three Pillars - 100% Chardonnay (Sonoma, California 2020)

Fresh minerality yet balanced profile, vibrant acidity, ripe stone fruit (peaches, nectarines).

Red Newt "Circle" - Riesling - (Finger Lakes, NY 2019)

Fruit flavors of tangerine, apricot, citrus and honeysuckle. Crisp and slightly sweet.

L'Escarelle "June 21st" - Rose (IGP Méditerranée, France 2020) - Juicy, red berry and orange pith flavors. Closes on a gently peachy note.

REDS

Three Pillars - Pinot Noir - (Sonoma, California 2020)

From the 'Los Carneros' region, renowned for producing expressive classically deep red/black fruit aromas of raspberry, blackberry and cherry. Supple texture and lush berry finish.

Andeluna Malbec '1300' - Malbec - (Mendoza, Argentina 2020) - Intense bright and purple in color. Floral violet notes in the beginning with red plum, strawberry and blackberry. Fresh, smooth and balanced in the mouth, with a subtle mineral texture.

(9.00 Glass, \$24.00 Bottle)

Terra d'Alter - Alicante Bouschet Red (Alentejano, Portugal, 2016) Color purple-red very dense and dark. Intense notes of dark fruit and spice with a floral nuance. Plums and prune notes, great acidity and structure.

(\$10.00 Glass, \$25.00 Bottle)

One Stone - 100% Cabernet Sauvignon - (Paso Robles, California 2020) The name "One Stone" is a tribute to the women who move mountains one stone at a time. Complex aromas of red fruits and toasted oak complemented by layers of ripe cherry, plum and coffee.

Sugarloaf Mountain Circe - Red Blend - (Montgomery County, Maryland 2021) Light-bodied red meant to drink young. A great example of how a fruit forward, early release wine can have complexity and depth. Aged for 7 months in french oak.

SPARKLING/ DESSERT WINES

Vietti Moscato d'Asti (Asti, Italy 2020) - Sweet, fresh, floral, lychee, tropical fruit, spring air, mandarin orange **(\$8.00 Glass, \$24.00 Bottle)**

Lakewood Candeo "Prosecco" (Finger Lakes, NY) - Fizzy, fruity, Dry - **(\$10.00 glass)**

Mimosa - Prosecco plus orange juice - **(\$13.00 glass)**

Sera Luce - (Naples, New York) Sera Luce is similar to an aperol spritz. So, while it is wine based and fizzy, it has sweet and savory characteristics like orange peel & herbs. **(\$10.00 Glass)**

BEER

- On Tap -

FRESH AS! - IPA (Astro Lab Brewing, Silver Spring, MD): This IPA is fresh and bright. Fruit and tropical juice notes on the nose that follow to the palate with white grape, citrus, passion fruit, and pine flavors. Moderate carbonation leads to a lush finish. **(7.1% ABV) \$7.50**

Green Apple - Traditional Cider (Angry Orchard Co, Walden, NY): Angry Orchard Green Apple has a bright, fresh apple aroma, with notes of honeydew melon and kiwi. This cider is slightly tart with balanced sweetness, reminiscent of a fresh green apple. **(5% ABV) \$7.00**

Optimal Wit - Wheat Beer /Witbier (Port City Brewing, Alexandria, VA): Similar to a Hefewiezen, This Unfiltered Wheat Beer with Orange Peel, Coriander, and Grains of Paradise (relative of ginger root). A light and refreshing beer, with a balance of drinkability and complexity. Crisp, citrus flavor with spice and a subtle pepperiness on the finish. **(4.9% ABV) \$7.50**

120 Minute IPA (Dogfish Head Brewery, Milton, DE): 120 Minute IPA is continually hopped with a copious amount of high-alpha American hops throughout the boil and whirlpool, and then dry-hopped with a boatload of hops. Unfiltered and abundantly hoppy, it's the Holy Grail for hopheads! **(15-20% ABV) \$7.50 *80Z POUR***

Surrender RyePA "Surrender Dorothy" (7 Locks Brewing, Rockville, MD): Medium bodied, red colored beer. Resinous hop aroma and flavor combined with the slight spice imparted by the rye make for a unique take on a hoppy beer. **(6.2% ABV) \$6.50**

Manor Hill Pilsner (Manor Hill Brewing, Ellicott City, MD): Leaf Saaz, Hallertau Mittelfruh and Triple Pearl hops provide a distinct German grassiness that is followed by a touch of grain, citrus and a clean finish. **(5.3% ABV) \$6.00**
